

Minutes from 5/13/2019

Pledge of allegiance said.

Issues from previous meeting:

Picnic area sign has been replaced.

Grant township hall has been reserved and paid for annual meeting July 6, 2019.

Steve Cohoon states damn area needs to be cleaned and sprayed for weeds. Cleaning after this holiday weekend.

Bids are going to be taken for silt trap cleaning. Bids will be taken from Marsh and Bushy when they can get it done.

Newsletter will be ready and go out with this year's dues. Reviewed a copy of newsletter and approved it.

All current area representatives and Secretary position will be elected this year at the annual meeting.

Replaced floats on swim area.

Loon floats must be replaced. Ralph will get cost for this.

Road repair in next 2-3 weeks is due.

Previous meeting meetings was reviewed and unanimously approved with Ralph making motion and Paul seconding this motion.

New issues:

Issue of leaf pick up discussed and due to cost this issue was dropped.

State of Michigan has a grant for invasive species permit refund. Application will be available June 1, 2019. History of lake required which we have available. Issues discussed and decided we will apply and provide all necessary background required to get our lake to be the pilot lake that will be hopefully used for this new project. If we are selected our lake will be reimbursed for our permission to spray our lake which means \$800 reimbursement would be given our lake. All agreed this would be great.

Fish survey currently being conducted on our lake by the DNR. This is done every 15 years.

Weeds will be treated once lake temperature is approve 55 degrees it is now 56 degrees so weeds will be treated soon.

Loons and Geese on nests with loons nesting about 20 feet from the geese. Geese are on artificial nest which loons do not seem to like.

Motion to email loon floats cost and purchase 2 at the best price made by Ralph and seconded by Steve. All members approved of this purchase.

Motion to accept treasurers report first and seconded and all members approved this report.

Area representatives:

Discussed the rule that no businesses are allowed in our subdivision and that there is a 20 by 40 netting fence on Five Lakes Drive with plants growing that maybe illegal. Caregivers are allowed 12 plants per individuals needing pain relief. Decision was to notify authorities and let them handle issue.

Reminder that 6 foot fence is allowed in our subdivision as it standard for suppliers.
